### TARIFF UPDATE: BLAAUWBERG NATURE RESERVE

Dear Visitor

The City of Cape Town amends its tariff schedule on an annual basis.

Below are the Council approved tariffs that are applicable at the Blaauwberg Nature Reserve from **1 July 2013 to 30 June 2014**.

These tariffs are charged at the main entrance at Eerstestein Resort, Otto Du Plessis Drive, Bloubergstrand.

#### Fauna Management: City Wide

<b>Call out fee</b>	per hour	If greater than 500 meters from a reserve, subject to resource availability. No fee will be charged for collection of species of conservation concern.	<b>R 120.00</b>

Film shoots, weddings, anniversaries, concerts and other events. Subject to the reserve management plan and Film & Events Policy and tariffs
