ANNUAL TARIFF UPDATE: 1 JULY 2020 TO 30 JUNE 2021

The Council of the City of Cape Town amends the city's tariff schedule on an annual basis. The new Council-approved tariffs will be valid from 1 July 2020 to 30 June 2021.

All people using facilities in the Blaauwberg Nature Reserve, or entering the Eerstestein Resort, must comply with the required tariffs for specified activities. Friends of the Blaauwberg Conservation Area may access the main entrance gate free of charge. The updated tariffs are detailed below:
